of our committee members. Dave and Regina were out judging the Christmas decorating contest. Bruce

Durand stepped up to offer in any way, and he will assist with the Vendors.

Linda - will place the order for signage the last week of December – first of January.

Linda will get banners made by the Sheriff's Dept at the end of the month/early January to be hung

approximately 4-6 weeks prior to the event. The DPW will hang the banners.

would like to participate at Last Night selling fries and meatball subs, all homemade.

Linda reached out to other non-profits to see if they'll serve food items. Lions Club, Elks, Mason's,

Knights of Columbus, Scout Pack 180, and Friends of the Ludlow 250th. Elaine will verify with the First

Church to ask if they'll participate.

Hubbard Memorial Library will participate doing something fun for kids.

Kid's Corner – Kathy will check on what's available for projects such as a craft with beads. Committee

Members are asked to assist with this task. Crafts to make will include marshmallow snowmen, coloring pages,

WARE radio will broadcast live in the morning to not only play music, but to advertise the event. They will also
