- FY 2026 Budget Calendar

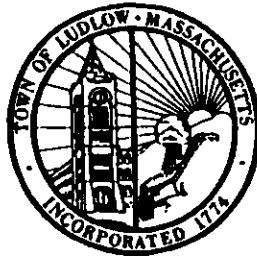

There is some discussion about pulling the article for the Public Safety HVAC system from Town Meeting. That will be revisited. Current deficit is \$465,801. Trash fee was also discussed. School Committee budget reduction was discussed.

Mr. Kelliher read the list of topics to be looking into: Health Insurance, possibility of Police overtime reduction of \$50,000 with help from FinCom reserve, removing benefits for the Vet's Center Admin Assistant that was denied from part time to full time, \$50,000 estimate in income from trash, and deferring the Public Safety HVAC. Without the insurance that comes to \$200,000.
