The meeting began at 6:30 p.m. in the Selectmen's Conference Room.

Mark Stinson of DEP was present at the meeting.

Continued Public Hearing – Notice of Intent – Laura Ernst – National Grid – Existing Electric Transmission ROW (Assessors' Map 41, Parcels 29, 35, 41) (DEP #207-XXX) (replace wood structures and Optical Ground Wire along the existing 301 transmission line)

The applicant was not present for the public hearing.

The continued public hearing opened at 6:30 p.m.

The applicant had previously reviewed the project at the August 6, 2025, meeting. Ms. Tierney read the email from Eileen Piskura that stated that the Notice of Intent was filed under the Bylaw only, therefore the DEP would not issue a number for the filing.

Ms. Lebel MOVED to approve the Notice of Intent for National Grid existing electric transmission row Assessors Map 41 Parcels 29, 35 and 41.

The public meeting opened at 6:35 p.m.

Ms. Tierney read the letter from Chief Ryan Pease stating that the work will include removal of a small grass area and installation of gravel and then asphalt pavement. There will also be pavement with a berm to guide storm water to the existing asphalt area and away from the stream and that best practices will be used to contain any erosion within the work area. Ms. Tierney also read the waiver request of the filing fee.

Ms. Lebel **MOVED** to issue a negative determination for the Request for Determination for the Ludlow Fire Department, 612 Chapin Street.

SECOND Mr. Cerqueira.

Ms. Lebel MOVED to waive the filing fee for the Request for Determination for the Fire Department. SECOND Mr. Cerqueira.

Ms. Lebel **MOVED** to close the public meeting for the Request for Determination for the Fire Department, 612 Chapin.

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Request for Certificate of Compliance – Lot 11 Leland Drive (207-0463)

Ms. Tierney explained that the whole subdivision was filed under one Notice of Intent, and that no work has been done on the lot that's being sold.

Ms. Lebel **MOVED** to issue a partial Certificate of Compliance for Lot 11 on Leland Drive. **SECOND** Mr. Cerqueira. **4-0** in Favor.

Public Meeting – Request for Determination – Hemlock Ridge, LLC c/o Mr. Armand Deslauriers – 1252 East Street & 0 Ventura Street (Assessors' Map 31, Parcels 127 & 121B) (to confirm whether wetland boundaries are accurately delineated)

In attendance: Rob Levesque - R Levesque & Associates; Armand Deslauriers

The public meeting opened at 6:45 p.m.

Mr. Levesque explained that they're requesting a determination on the wetland boundaries on the subject property only and are not proposing any work at this time. He said that the property is approximately 71 acres and is located at the corner of East and Ventura Street. He pointed out the lighter green areas on the plan that are void of forested areas, and that the darker green is the bordering vegetated wetland that runs through the property. Mr. Levesque also commented that there's an intermittent stream associated with the bordering vegetated wetland and that they have done all the work to determine that that stream is in fact intermittent.

The Commission agreed that a peer review will be necessary due to the size of the property.

Mr. Lebel **MOVED** to continue the Request for Determination for Hemlock Ridge to October 1, 2025, at 6:30.

SECOND Mr. Cerqueira.

4-0 in Favor.

Steve Riberdy will be contacted to see if he can complete the peer review on the property.

The public meeting was continued until October 1, 2025, at 6:30 p.m.

Possible digging near culvert near 111 Miller Street

A resident had called the office regarding possible digging in the creek near 111 Miller Street. Ms. Lebel went out to inspect the issue and said that the intermittent stream was dry and that the DPW had repaired the damaged culvert under the road. She also mentioned that previously the homeowner had been

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warned to make sure he maintains everything away from the stream and that she will contact them again as a reminder.
