

OUTREACH...

FUEL ASSISTANCE RECERTIFICATION

If you have received your recertification application, it is very important that you bring ALL the following paperwork to your appointment in order for the application to be complete:

- Recertification application (light green)
 - Identification
- •Proof of all income in your household
- Copy of oil, gas or electric bill (source of heating)
- •A complete copy of your most recent electric bill.
 - Copy of water, sewer bill

We still have not received applications for new applicants.

Remember Fuel Assistance starts November 1, 2025 and ends April 30, 2026. There is still plenty of time to sign up and it is NOT first come, first served.

For more information or to schedule an appointment call (413) 583-3564. You must have an appointment. Please DO NOT drop off paperwork. At this time, appointments are for those aged 60 and over and are LUDLOW residents.

OPEN ENROLLMENT BEGINS!

If you have a Medicare Prescription Plan or a Medicare Advantage Plan (HMO, PPO), you will receive information from your health and prescription plan providers.

Please read and save this information regarding changes to your plan for 2025.

- Open enrollment is October 15 through December 7 and your new coverage will begin January 1, 2026.
- You can change from original Medicare to a Medicare Advantage Plan and vice versa.
- You can switch from one Medicare Advantage Plan to another.
- Change you Medicare Prescription Drug Plan.
- Join a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan.
- Switch from one prescription plan to another.
- Change your Medicare supplement.

We know this sounds confusing but our SHINE counselor can help you understand your plan changes, as well as all the other options available to you. SHINE offers free, confidential counseling on all aspects of Medicare and related health insurance programs.

MOBILE DENTAL HYGIENE SERVICES OF WESTERN MASS

Manda Day, RDH will be here by appointment to provide dental services. Services include blood pressure screening, dental screening, oral cancer screening, dental education, teeth cleaning, polishing, denture cleaning and inspection.

- Dental cleaning of your own teeth is \$75 and includes removal of plaque, tarter and other debris from the patient's teeth with autoclavable instruments.
