
The Commission anticipates that it will convene in an Executive Session in conjunction with its review of FanDuel’s methods of KYC in accordance with G.L. c. 30A, § 21(a)(7), G. L. c. 4, § 7(26)(n), and G.L. c. 23N, § 6(i) to review certain materials in connection with the sports wagering operator’s processes and parameters during account creation related to customer verification and authentication, as these matters relate to cyber security within the Commonwealth, the public discussion or disclosure of which is likely to jeopardize public safety or cyber security, and further, which constitute trade secrets, competitively-sensitive information or proprietary information, the disclosure of which would be detrimental to the operator.
