2. **Call to Order** – Judy called the meeting to order at 5:31
3. **Approve minutes** – March 11, 2026 - minutes were reviewed – Julie made a motion to approve the minutes, Steve seconded, all approved
4. **Update on April 7<sup>th</sup> Selectboard meeting** – Judy thanked members for attending selectboard meeting and requesting our budget funding for 2026. Budget was approved for treating Havaland, Harris, Murphy, Alden and reserves for Minechoag permit and potential treatment if permit is approved.
5. **Update on Minechoag Permit process** – Judy provided an update that Goddard Consulting and Water and Wetland met with NHESP to discuss potential treatment plans that would not impact potential protected plants. Judy will continue to update the committee
