Next meeting will be Thursday, September 10, 2026.

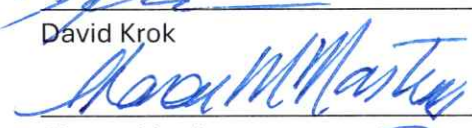

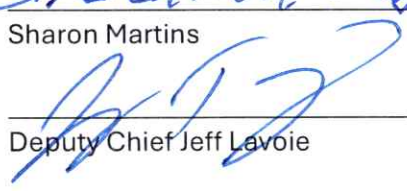
